

Carlo MORASSO - CV

Dr. Carlo Morasso is a senior scientist at the Laboratory of Nanomedicine and Molecular Imaging at Istituti Clinici Scientifici Maugeri, a research hospital located in Pavia, Italy. He holds an M.Sc. in pharmaceutical sciences and technologies (2005) and a Ph.D. in medicinal chemistry (2008) from the University of Milan. After completing his Ph.D., Dr. Morasso joined the London Centre for Nanotechnology at University College London, under the guidance of Prof. Rachel McKendry, working on the development of a new generation of HIV tests. In 2011, Dr. Morasso moved to the Laboratory of Nanomedicine and Clinical Biophotonics (LABION) of the Don Carlo Gnocchi Foundation, focusing on the use of Raman spectroscopy for biomedical applications. In 2017, Dr. Morasso moved to ICS Maugeri, where he leads research initiatives for the hospital's breast cancer unit. Dr. Morasso is one of the founding members of the Italian Society for the Study of Extracellular Vesicles (EVIta) and is a member of the International Society for Clinical Spectroscopy (Clirspec).
